A Brush with Kindness (ABWK) is an exterior home preservation program for eligible homeowners so they can continue to live in safe, decent homes for years to come. ABWK is part of our larger Neighborhood Revitalization program and is designed to help revitalize neighborhoods, encourage connections within communities, and preserve local affordable housing inventory.

what we do

ABWK projects can include:

- Exterior painting
- Basic landscaping
- Minor exterior repairs
- Pressure washing
- Lead-based paint testing
- Clean up

how it works

Alachua Habitat uses volunteer labor and donated materials to keep the costs low. Homeowners pay a portion of the cost, and Alachua Habitat offers affordable payment plans to help stretch payments over the course of several months. We partner with Gainesville's Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) for all ABWK projects.

eligibility

In order to qualify for ABWK, applicants/homes must:

- Be homeowner-occupied
- Have property taxes paid in full
- Carry homeowners insurance
- Be in no danger of foreclosure
- Have no current code violations
- Have a household income below 60% of AMI (Area Median Income) as defined each year by HUD
- Demonstrate willingness and ability to pay
- Be willing to partner with Alachua Habitat through "sweat equity"
- Be located in the designated Neighborhood Revitalization area
